

## Team 7D Homework Policy and Classroom Expectations

When you turn in any assignment it must have your full name, date that it is handed in, and class in the upper right-hand corner of the paper. All papers must be neatly stapled and ready to hand in at the start of class. You cannot print out a paper during class time.

### **Nightly Homework**

---

Homework is assigned daily. Students are expected to write down assignments in class. Also, all assignments are posted online. Students should spend approximately thirty minutes on each subject every night.

There will be a loss of credit for daily assignments that are late, unless you are absent; therefore, for every day you are absent you have that many days to complete and turn in the assignment.

Upon return from an absence, YOU must check in with *all* of your teachers, turn in your homework that was due the day you were out and find out what you missed (homework, worksheets, notes, etc.).

If you do not understand an assignment, write down what you think the assignment is about, what three questions you have, and see the teacher for extra help the next morning.

### **Projects and Papers**

---

For every day that a major assignment (not homework) is late, your grade will be lowered *ten* points.

If your printer is not working, email your paper to Bigelow and you can print it out the next morning in the computer lab. Do not email your paper to the teacher.

### **Classroom Procedures**

---

*As you enter the class...*

- Sit in your assigned seat.
- Take out your materials for class.
- Begin the class activity and/or write down the homework assignment.

*During class...*

- Listen to the teacher.
- Raise your hand and wait to be called.
- If you need to use the bathroom or get a drink, fill out your own pass and sign out in the school's sign out log.
- Sharpen your pencil before class begins or when there is a break in class instruction.
- Return materials to the appropriate location when you are done.

*End of class...*

- We will continue to work until the end of the period.
- Your teacher will dismiss you and then you may begin to pack up your materials and exit the classroom quietly.
